## Hotels, Parking, and Getting Around:

- The CTA Blue Line Train has a stop right by UIC's campus (the UIC-Halsted stop) which connects UIC directly to O'hare airport and numerous hotel and airbnb options throughout Chicago. Midway airport is also accessible from campus using the CTA trains and buses. A \$5 day pass can be bought at any train station and can be used on both trains and buses.
